

Postdoc Researcher in Economics (Social Choice Theory)

The research center CRESE plans to recruit a post-doctoral researcher in Economics (Social Choice Theory) for a period of 12 months to start at September/October 2022.

The successful candidate will be located at Besançon, France.

The net salary is in the order of €26,000 per annum.

Context of the position

The overall project of the position deals with the ability of the various decision-making mechanisms to realize diversity goals. A diversified collective decision-making structure (e.g., an elected committee, parliaments, etc.) refers to its composition in relation to the gender balance, the participation of religious or ethnic minorities, age equality, disability, etc. The thematic goal of the position is to analyze the implications of diversity requirements for the design and functioning of collective decision-making bodies in politics and business.

The successful candidate should have the ability to carry out research activities specifically fitting with this objective.

Responsibilities

- Draft and co-author journal articles and working papers fitting with the objective of the project;
- Present work in seminars at CRESE and relevant international conferences;
- Co-organize a workshop related to the project;
- The post-doctoral fellow will have no teaching or administrative duties.
